# **Corona testing obligation**

All MUK sites may only be entered with a **valid negative CORONA test**. These must be shown to the porters on entry (antigen self-tests are not permitted as an entry test).

**Proof of having overcome COVID-19** disease exempts you from the testing obligation for **six months.** 

Proof of COVID-19 antibodies exempts from the testing obligation for three months.

We ask people who do not live in Vienna to also make use of testing services in their places of residence.

All existing COVID-19 safety measures of the MUK remain in place.

## How do I get a test?

#### 1. Gargle test (PCR test for home use)



All students and employees of the MUK (even without an Austrian national insurance number) can take regular PCR gargle tests free of charge as part of the "Wien – Alles gurgelt!" campaign! Registration and information

These tests can be collected from BIPA branches and handed in at any Vienna REWE branch (BIPA, Billa, Penny, ...).

# 2. Free COVID-19 tests at the test centres of the city of Vienna (antigen test)

The test centres are available for people without symptoms who live or work in Vienna or are staying there temporarily: https://coronavirus.wien.gv.at/teststrassen.

For people with symptoms, individual test centres offer a drive-in. An Austrian national insurance number is not required.



### 3. Corona tests in "check boxes" (antigen test)



In case of flu-like symptoms such as cold, fever, cough or sore throat, all Viennese citizens can go to a checkbox:

https://coronavirus.wien.gv.at/checkboxen. The checkboxes are mobile containers with a medical office. All patients are tested free of charge for a possible COVID-19 infection with rapid antigen tests before the treatments. Please bring your Austrian e-card with you to your appointment, as this will be used for identification.

The test result is available immediately and is valid for 48 hours counting from the time of testing.

#### 4. Free COVID-19 tests in pharmacies (antigen test)



Be sure to register for an **appointment at the pharmacy of your choice:** Register via <u>https://apotheken.oesterreich-testet.at</u> or via the free phone number 0800/220 330 daily from 7:00 to 22:00. Take your Austrian e-card with you to your test appointment, this will be used for identification.

The test result is available immediately and valid for 48 hours counting from the time of testing.

### 5. Self-tests at the MUK (antigen test)



From Mon, 12 April 2021, there will be the opportunity to take a self-test every Monday from 8:30 AM to 10:30 AM at the Bräunerstraße location.

This test only entitles the student to attend classes on the same day.
