## **Professorship for Music Theory**

up to 20 teaching hours per week (full teaching commitment) tenured employment contract

## We are looking for:

A person with high pedagogical competence and an academic doctorate in one of the field of music theory or musicology with a focus on music theory/analysis. Applicants should have a track record of outstanding research activities, as well as international lecturing and publishing activities. Furthermore, experience in, or willingness to acquire, third-party funding in the field of research, knowledge of current methods and concepts as well as didactic skills and teaching experience at university level are expected. Having some experience in university self-administration and a willingness to develop the subject innovatively and work in an interdisciplinary manner are expected. Additionally, expertise in the field of Artistic Research is desirable (see also Artistic Research at <a href="https://www.muk.ac.at/artistic-research">www.muk.ac.at/artistic-research</a>).

## Your responsibilities (see responsibilities of professors in \$18 at www.muk.ac.at/satzung):

- → Leading courses in music theory (including analysis, composition, aural training, solfeggio, elementary composition)
- → Representation and further development of the Department of Music Theory in research and teaching
- → Supervision of final theses
- → Supervision of Artistic Research doctoral theses
- → International research and publication activities
- → Acquisition of third-party funding
- → Participation in the development and development of the arts and involvement in academic self-administration within the framework of the entire university

After the documents have been reviewed by the committee, appointed in accordance with the appointment regulations (see Satzung at <a href="www.muk.ac.at/satzung">www.muk.ac.at/satzung</a>), selected applicants will be invited to a hearing (consisting of an academic presentation, teaching practice and colloquium) on 21 January 2025 or 22 January 2025. The main teaching language at the MUK is German. The willingness to acquire appropriate German language skills within the first year of employment is required.

- → Curriculum vitae with special consideration of pedagogical, scholarly and, if applicable, artistic activities (incl. list of publications, list of works if applicable), exposé of a current research project (max. 5 A4 pages), three examples of publications (articles/chapters)
- → Proof of relevant degrees and other qualifications

A full teaching position is endowed with a gross annual salary of at least EUR 53.376,26.
