

The following position is available at the Music and Arts University of the City of Vienna starting from the academic year 2024/2025*:

Professorship for Jazz Drums and Rhythm Training

Up to as many as 16 teaching hours per week (80% of a full teaching position)

We are looking for:

A personality with credentials demonstrating outstanding professional activity as well as pedagogical experience in the field of jazz drums. An adequate academic degree is required. Expertise in the field of artistic research is desirable (see www.muk.ac.at/artistic-research).

Your responsibilities (see responsibilities of professors in §16 at www.muk.ac.at/satzung):

The successful candidate will be expected to lead a jazz drum class and independently and regularly conduct lessons (both drum students and rhythm training group classes for all jazz students), work in cooperation with the faculty, be willing to design and participate in interdepartmental university projects and the associated administrative work. Furthermore, participation in the field of EEK ("Entwicklung und Erschließung der Künste", which translates into "development of the arts") as well as involvement in academic self-administration within the framework of the university as a whole will be required.

Please attach to your letter of application:

- Curriculum vitae with special reference to artistic, pedagogical and (if applicable) artistic research activities
- Evidence of relevant degrees and other qualifications
- Audio sample(s) totalling min. 10 to max. 15 minutes (to be submitted in digital form only, e.g. as streaming or download links)
- Pedagogical concept (max. three DIN A4 pages) for the jazz drum students in the Bachelor's programme. The stylistic/ pedagogical division of the Bachelor's programme at MUK should also be included in the concept (see www.muk.ac.at/jazz).

After the documents have been reviewed by the commission appointed according to the provisions of the appointment regulations (see [Satzung at www.muk.ac.at/satzung](http://www.muk.ac.at/satzung)), selected applicants will be invited to a **hearing** (consisting of an artistic presentation, teaching demonstration and Q&A with the commission) on the **27th or 28th of May 2024**.

The language of instruction at the MUK is German. The willingness to acquire appropriate German language skills within the first year of employment is required.

A teaching obligation of 16 teaching hours per week is to be remunerated with a gross annual salary of at least EUR 42.700,98.

The MUK represents an anti-discriminatory employment policy and strives for equal opportunities and diversity. We especially aim for an increased number of women in leading positions and in the teaching personnel. Women with equal qualifications will be given priority. Unfortunately, costs incurred in connection with an application to the Music and Arts Private University of the City of Vienna cannot be reimbursed.
