- Defined compulsory optional modules:** For the successful completion of a compulsory optional module a minimum of 6 ECTS-points has to be reached by passing the listed courses of the compulsory optional module (linked module). The listed courses are electable within the linked module. In accordance with the available resources the given compulsory optional modules may be attended repeatedly.
- Individual compulsory optional modules:** Students may create compulsory optional modules individually; they are required to submit title and content for approval to the study commission.
- Elective Courses:** Freely electable courses (no approval needed!) in order to complete the given ECTS workload
