

Erasmus-Application at MUK

Have the following documents ready:

- Passport photo
- Scanned / photographed photo ID
- Examination program (title, composer, etc.)
- Link to application video(s)
- Name and email address of your International Relations Coordinator
- Transcript of Records
- Curriculum Vitae (unformatted)
- Letter of motivation (unformatted)

Step 1: Video recording

The artistic self-presentation is an important part of your application. The video should be approx. 20 minutes long and reflect your artistic skills. The repertoire is freely selectable. (For composition: Composers can prepare a representative selection of their works instead of an artistic self-presentation. This can be written documents, sheet music or videos).

Step 2: Upload video

Please upload your video to a video platform (e.g. Dailymotion, Vimeo, YouTube, etc.). The video must be freely accessible (e.g. "unlisted" on YouTube).

(For composition: Depending on the type of documents, please upload them to a suitable platform where they are accessible via a link and without login).

Step 3: Account creation

After entering your details, an activation link will be sent to the email address you have provided. You can use this to enter your login details and log in to MUKonline.
